
Czech Dragon Boat Association (CZDBA) and the Organizing Committee in conjunction with the European Dragon Boat Federation (EDBF) warmly invite all National Dragon Boat Teams to participate in the 15th EDBF NATIONS DRAGON BOAT CHAMPIONSHIPS for the distances 200m, 500m and 2000m.

DATE:

The 15th EDBF NATIONS DRAGON BOAT CHAMPIONSHIPS together with 19th Open Czech National Dragon Boat Club Crew Championships will be held from 4th to 7th July 2024 at the National Olympic Centre Regatta Course – Labe Arena Račice.

LOCATION:

National Olympic Centre Regatta Course, the location of the 2009 IDBF World Championship, 2014 EDBF European Championships and location of Czech National Championships is just 30 minutes from Prague and has successfully organized various water sport events at European and World level in the past and provides ideal conditions and facilities for the athletes as well as for spectators. The regatta course and whole complex has been recently renovated and is like brand new! It is situated in the north of Prague, and it takes about 30 minutes by car on the new highway. A shuttle service between the accommodations and the regatta venue will be organized. Accommodation will be available in Račice and neighbor location.

THE RACING:

Racing will be conducted in both small and standard boats:

- Divisions: Premier, Senior A, Senior B, Senior C, Senior D, 24U, Junior A, Junior B and Paradragon
- Classes: Open, Women and Mixed
- Distance: 200m, 500m, 1,000 and 2,000m.

Racing will be conducted in accordance with:

- IDBF Competition Regulations (Edition 9.0 (January 2024))
- IDBF Rules of Racing (Edition) Edition 9.0 (January 2024)
- IDBF Rules for Paradragon Racing (Edition 1.3) (December 2023)



THE VENUE - REGATTA COURSE:

The regatta course has 6 lanes of 12 meters for 200 and 500 m, using the Albano system. Starts are equipped with the automatic start system Polaritas and new fixed starting blocks.

The total length of the water canal is 2350 meters and the width of main canal is 130 meters. The depth is 2.5–3 meters.

Photo finish and computerized results processing will be provided at the finish tower on site. There is a huge grandstand for spectators and guests incl. parking place available. VIP guests of the OrgCom and EDBF will be able to enjoy the races from the VIP area with a view over the whole regatta course.

FEE PAYMENT:

Entry fees have two components: an amount paid to EDBF (the 'EDBF Registration Fee') and an amount paid to the event organizer (the 'Entry Fee').

EDBF Registration Fee: € 30 per team member/ coach / manager /medic, Junior A / B € 15, Supportes € 15 **Entry Fee:** € 80 for adults 19of age and over and € 35 for Juniors and Supporters after confirmed entry till 30th April.

• 2 sets of 6 Standard Boats + 2 spare / 2 sets of 6 Small Boats + 2 spare Competing crews are expected to bring their own paddles that confirm to the IDBF Paddle Specification.

IDBF is a signatory to The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA). IDBF is committed to ensuring that its athletes comply with WADA requirements. The EDBF follows the IDBF Anti-Doping Policy, where it is relevant to EDBF Championships.

ACCOMMODATION & PARKING & TRANSFER:

Annex. 1

Clean Sport Education

In line with the World Anti-Doping Code and the IDBF Doping Control Rules, it is a mandatory requirement for the following athletes and all coaches to complete or have completed an Anti-Doping course before being eligible for registration/accreditation at the ENC 2024 in Recice.

All Premier Crew (including helm & drummer) must complete the International-Level Athletes Education Program. This course will give athletes information about the dangers of doping, the importance of anti-doping controls and promote positive attitudes to avoiding doping.

All Coaches must complete the **High-Performance Coaches' Education Program**. This course provides Anti- Doping education for High Performance Coaches with an emphasis on why clean sport matters and how it protects athletes' experiences and opportunities in sport.

- However, you can do the course in any language provided by the website but when creating
 the account, please enter the correct identity information using your full name in English.

*Any athletes/Coaches with a current Anti-Doping course certificate must make sure it is valid until 4th Aug 2024 (if you have completed it before and it is still valid, you do not need to do it again)

ALL certificates should be submitted online no later than 25 July. The information regarding the submission process and the platform will be published separately by the end of May 2024.

Doping Control

In line with the World Anti-Doping Code and the IDBF Doping Control Rules, EDBF will conduct random drug testing at this competition. All tests will be set against the current WADA banned substances list as shown on the WADA Website. Members of the EDBF Medical and Sports Science Commission will be on hand to monitor the testing process.

Premier athletes who takes prescribed substances or use methods prohibited by WADA for medical reasons, should submit a Therapeutic Use Exception Application Form (TUE) to the IDBF medical Commission, chair-medical@dragonboat.sport no later than 30 Jun 2024.

Please note that EDBF Medical Commission is not responsible for any TUE submitted to the IDBF, therefore, for any question regarding the submission of TUEs please only contact chair-medical@dragonboat.sport

The TUE and information on the TUE process along with Checklists are available for download from the IDBF website site. Please note the following points when preparing a TUE:

- 1. Inform your doctor that you are an athlete. If any of your medications are prohibited ask your doctor for a suitable alternative that is not prohibited.
- 2. Only those prescribed medications that are on the prohibited list require a TUE.
- All medical evidence (diagnosis, medical history, test results etc. as stated on the TUE form at point 6) must be submitted with the TUE for it to be processed otherwise the TUE application will be returned. This can then be re-submitted once all required documentation has been collected.
- 4. All submissions of TUE to be in PDF document format.

Please note the EDBF only required Premier athletes who are undertaking prescribed substances or use methods prohibited by WADA to submit their TUEs. Athletes in other categories are not required to provide such documents for the ENC 2024.

National Clean Sport Advisor:

The EDBF Medical and Sport Science Commission is pleased to announce that we will organize a 4 hours clean sport advisors course during the ENC 2024, (date to be announced in Bulletin 3). This course is about the role of and responsibilities of Clean Sport Advisors in protecting clean sport and how to operate in line with the EDBF's anti-doping rules. It will provide information to effectively support athletes so that they meet their anti- doping roles and responsibilities, and it will explain what is expected from you when you suspect doping.

At the end of the course candidates will receive the EDBF Clean Sport Certificate which will entitle the recipient to act as a National Clean Sport advisor for their EDBF Member.

At least one person is invited from each EDBF Member to attend the workshop which is free to attend.

From 2026, WADA will require all sports to have a Certified Clean Sport Advisor as part of their national teams, The EDBF will be complying with this WADA directive therefore, It is highly desirable that EDBF Members nominate people to attend this first Clean Sport Advisors Workshop during the ENC2024.
